

The following Privacy Policy summarizes the various ways that **DARE Halton** treats the information you provide while using **www.darehalton.com** ("Website"). It is our goal to bring you information that is tailored to your individual needs and, at the same time, protect your privacy. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. If you do not agree with the terms and conditions of this Privacy Policy, please do not use this Website. This Privacy Policy does not cover information collected elsewhere, including without limitation offline and on sites linked to from the Website. This Privacy Policy may be modified from time to time; the date of the most recent revisions will appear on this page, so check back often. Continued access of the Website by you will constitute your acceptance of any changes or revisions to the Privacy Policy.

1. THE TYPE OF INFORMATION THE WEBSITE COLLECTS

The Website may collect personally identifying information with your specific knowledge and consent. For instance, when you complete a survey, make a donation, subscribe to our publication(s), or register for any portion of our services, you may be asked to provide information such as your e-mail address, name or phone number. Optional information such as your age or gender may also be requested.

2. HOW THE WEBSITE USES INFORMATION PROVIDED BY YOU

- Personal Information** is information that can be used to identify you such as your name, address, telephone number, or email address. - Demographic information** is anonymous information such as your age, date of birth, gender, hobbies, interests, zip/postal code or country. Demographic information is not considered Personal Information unless it is linked to Personal Information about a specific user. - Aggregate information** is anonymous data about individuals that is grouped together to study a group or category of services or users. Aggregate information is not considered Personal Information unless it is linked to Personal Information about a specific user.

All information collected is used to enhance your online experience only. We do not sell, rent or disclose Personal, Demographic or Aggregate Information to any third parties.

3. COOKIES

You may have read about "cookies," nuggets of information that are placed by a Website in a storage place on your own computer.
